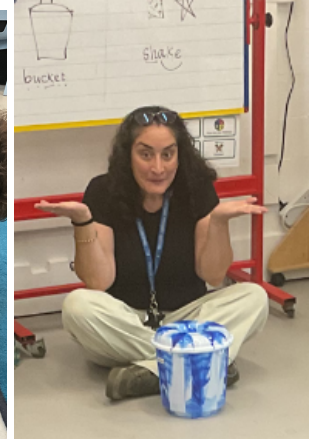


STEPHEN WILTSHIRE CLASS WEEKLY REVIEW
